By letter dated December 24, 2014, the interim Executive Director of the California Public Utilities Commission granted the request made by Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("Utility"), San Diego Gas & Electric Company, Southern California Edison Company, and Southern California Gas Company for a one-year extension to file their next cost of capital applications. As a result, the Utility's next cost of capital application will be due on April 20, 2016 and the current automatic adjustment mechanism will remain in place until the new filing date.
