(1) On May 25, 2005, the common stock of the Issuer split 2-for-1, resulting in the reporting person's acquisition of 45,973 additional shares of common stock.

(2) Part of a grant to the reporting person of 40,000 shares from the Issuer's 1995 Stock Plan. The options vested in five equal annual installments beginning 2/12/1999. This option was previously reported as covering 20,000 shares at an exercise price of \$23.69 per share, but was adjusted to reflect the stock split on May 25, 2005.

(3) Part of a grant to the reporting person of 40,000 shares from the Issuer's 2000 Stock Plan. The options vest(ed) in five equal annual installments beginning 02/10/2001. This option was previously reported as covering 20,000 shares at an exercise price of \$29.81 per share, but was adjusted to reflect the stock split on May 25, 2005.

(4) Part of a grant to the reporting person of 15,000 shares from the Issuer's 2000 Stock Plan. The options vest(ed) in five equal annual installments beginning 02/09/2002. This option was previously reported as covering 7,500 shares at an exercise price of \$38.03 per share, but was adjusted to reflect the stock split on May 25, 2005.

(5) Part of a grant to the reporting person of 20,000 shares from the Issuer's 2000 Stock Plan. The options vest(ed) in five equal annual installments beginning 02/07/2003. This option was previously reported as covering 10,000 shares at an exercise price of \$33.73 per share, but was adjusted to reflect the stock split on May 25, 2005.

(6) Part of a grant to the reporting person of 10,000 shares from the Issuer's 2000 Stock Plan. The options vest(ed) in five equal annual installments beginning 11/26/2003. This option was previously reported as covering 5,000 shares at an exercise price of \$35.68 per share, but was adjusted to reflect the stock split on May 25, 2005.
