**Adjustment to exchange price of Exchangeable Bonds due in 2014**

Portugal Telecom SGPS, S.A. ( PT ) informs that the exchange price of Portugal Telecom International Finance B.V. Euro 750,000,000 4.125% Exchangeable Bonds due in 2014 (ISIN XS0309600848, Common code 030960084) and exchangeable into ordinary shares of PT (the Bonds) in accordance with Condition 6.2(c)(i) of the Bonds was adjusted.

Effective on 28 December 2010, the Exchange Price is Euro 11.06. Thus, each holder of a Bond in a principal amount of Euro 50,000 will be entitled to receive 4,520 shares of Portugal Telecom SGPS, S.A. upon exercise of Exchange Rights, under the Terms and Conditions of the Bonds.
