## Explanation of Responses:

- (1) Each restricted stock unit ("RSU") has the economic equivalent of one share of CIT common stock.
- (2) Restricted stock units are scheduled to vest 100% on the first anniversary of the date of grant and shall settle 100% in shares of CIT common stock.
- (3) Fractional shares were paid in cash upon scheduled vesting and settlement of restricted stock units.  
RSUs are scheduled to vest in three equal installments on the first, second and third anniversaries of the date of grant and are payable
- (4) 50% in shares of CIT common stock and 50% in cash. The cash payment shall be based on the closing price of CIT common stock on the vesting date.
- (5) Filer elected to receive 100% stock upon settlement.
- (6) Filer elected to defer settlement of these RSUs as DSUs until he is no longer a member of the Board of CIT.

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- (7) Each Deferred Share Unit is the economic equivalent of one share of CIT common stock.
- (8) Filer elected to defer issuance of stock until he is no longer a member of the Board.
- (9) Deferred share units ("DSU") will expire and settle in shares of common stock upon filer's departure from the Board.
