### Item 5.02. Appointment of Certain Officers.

Anika Therapeutics, Inc. (the “Company”) appointed Richard Hague, 55, as its Chief Commercial Officer, effective as of October 26, 2015. From November 2014 through the present, Mr. Hague was the Vice President Sales and Marketing at TEI Medical where he was responsible for driving the revenue growth of that corporation’s dermal scaffold product, as well as for the build out of its sales and marketing teams. From 2011 through 2014, Mr. Hague was Vice President Sales, Marketing, and Commercial Operations for Sanofi Biosurgery’s Cell Therapy and Regenerative Medicine group.
