This Amendment does not reflect events occurring after the filing of the original report (i.e., those events occurring after May 22, 2017) or modify or update those disclosures that may be affected by subsequent events. Accordingly, this Amendment should be read in conjunction with the 2016 Annual Report and the registrant's other filings with the SEC.

In connection with our audits of the consolidated financial statements, we also have audited, before the effects of the adjustments to retrospectively reflect discontinued operations discussed in Note 3 to the consolidated financial statements, the consolidated financial statement schedules II to IV, as of December 31, 2015 and for the years ended December 31, 2015 and 2014. The 2015 and 2014 financial statements and schedules before the effects of these adjustments discussed in Note 3 are not presented herein. The 2015 and 2014 consolidated financial statements and financial statement schedules are the responsibility of the Company's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these consolidated financial statements and financial statement schedules based on our audits.

Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall financial statement presentation. We believe that our audits provide a reasonable basis for our opinion.

In our opinion, the consolidated financial statements referred to above, before the effects of the adjustments to retrospectively reflect discontinued operations discussed in Note 3 to the consolidated financial statements, present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of Independence Holding Company and subsidiaries as of December 31, 2015, and the results of their operations and their cash flows for each of the years in the two year period ended December 31, 2015, in conformity with U.S. generally accepted accounting principles. Also in our opinion, the related financial statement schedules, when considered in relation to the basic consolidated financial statements taken as a whole, present fairly, in all material respects, the information set forth therein.

We were not engaged to audit, review, or apply any procedures to the adjustments to retrospectively reflect discontinued operations discussed in Note 3 to the consolidated financial statements, we do not express an opinion or any other form of assurance about whether such adjustments are appropriate and have been properly applied.
