On November 13, 2007, Brian Gentile resigned as Chief Marketing Officer and Executive Vice President of Marketing of Informatica Corporation (Informatica), effective December 7, 2007.

In connection with his resignation, Mr. Gentile entered into a severance agreement with Informatica (the Severance Agreement). Pursuant to the Severance Agreement, Mr. Gentile will receive a lump-sum payment, less applicable withholdings, equivalent to two months of his base salary, related COBRA benefits and allocable performance bonus payment. Also, Mr. Gentile is subject to a nonsolicitation covenant for six months, as well as customary confidentiality covenants.
