(Cayman), Special Situations Private Equity Fund, LP (PE), Special Situations Technology Fund, L.P. (Tech) and Special Situations Technology II, L.P. (Tech II), respectively. 731,000 shares of Common

(1) Stock and 350,000 Wts are held by Cayman, 1,563,800 shares of Common Stock and 750,000 Wts are held by PE, 218,000 shares of Common Stock and 105,000 Wts are held by Tech and 1,341,500 shares of Common Stock and 645,000 Wts are held by Tech II. The interest of Marxe and Greenhouse in the shares of Common Stock owned by Cayman, PE, Tech, and Tech II is limited to the extent of his pecuniary interest.
