- Mr. Miller received a retention grant of 22,442 restricted stock units under The AES Corporation 2003 Long Term Compensation Plan (the "Plan"). The grant is scheduled to vest in three equal annual installments beginning on February 23, 2008, if continued employment conditions are satisfied under the Plan. If these conditions are satisfied, each RSU entitles the holder to one share of AES Common stock
