### **VRG Implements New Flight Network**

**São Paulo, March 24, 2008** GOL Linhas Aéreas Inteligentes S.A. (NYSE: GOL and Bovespa: GOLL4), the parent company of Brazilian airlines GOL Transportes Aéreos S.A. (GTA, Brazil's low-cost, low-fare airline) and VRG Linhas Aéreas S.A. (VRG, Brazil's premium service airline), announces VRG's new network of domestic flights. The changes, which were initiated to broaden the Company's presence in high traffic business markets, will improve the Company's connectivity and distribution to several national destinations.

Planning for the new network included the recent lift of previous restrictions on connecting flights to Congonhas Airport, in São Paulo. From this airport, VRG will serve Belo Horizonte (Confins), Brasília, Curitiba, Florianópolis, Porto Alegre, Recife, Rio de Janeiro (Galeão and Santos Dumont) and Salvador.

The most significant change is the creation of a distribution *hub* in Brasília. As of today, customers can fly to Belo Horizonte (Confins), Fortaleza, Manaus, Porto Alegre, Recife, Rio de Janeiro (Galeão), São Paulo (Congonhas) and Salvador in direct flights from the federal capital. The number of flights to these destinations was also increased. Flights to Salvador, for example, now include three frequencies from Brasília, two from Rio de Janeiro (Galeão) and three from São Paulo (Congonhas).

With the new *hub* in Brasília and the return of connections to Congonhas, VRG will be able to offer more flight options to several destinations. The Company is growing and gaining a wider national route network, says Lincoln Amano, VRG's commercial director. The new network will allow the Company to increase aircraft utilization, productivity, efficiency, and flight loads in an intelligent way. Most importantly, it will allow VRG to broaden its customer services.

Operations to Brasília and from Congonhas will primarily be carried out by Boeing 737-700 and 737-800 *Next Generation* aircraft, which have the largest space between seats in the Brazilian domestic market.

GOL Linhas Aéreas Inteligentes S.A. is the parent company of Brazilian airlines GOL Transportes Aéreos S.A. (GTA, a low-cost, low-fare airline which operates the GOL brand) and VRG Linhas Aéreas S.A. GTA and VRG offer daily flights to more destinations in Brazil than any other domestic airline while providing customers with the most convenient flight schedules in the country. The airlines operate a young, modern fleet of Boeing aircraft, the safest and most comfortable aircraft of its class, with low maintenance, fuel and training costs, and high aircraft utilization and efficiency ratios. In addition to safe and reliable services, which stimulate brand recognition and customer satisfaction, the Company's service is recognized as the best value proposition in the market. Growth plans include increasing frequencies in existing markets and adding service to additional markets in both Brazil and other high-traffic travel destinations. Shares are listed on the NYSE (GOL) and the Bovespa (GOLL4) stock exchanges.
