The Amended and Restated Code of Ethics for Directors, Executive Officers, and Senior Financial Officers expands the policy to cover directors and all executive officers of the Company. It also adds provisions to address corporate opportunities and protection and use of Company assets, clarifies certain other provisions, and expressly incorporates by reference the provisions of the Company's Code of Ethical Business Conduct, which is applicable to all directors, officers, and employees of the Company and its direct and indirect subsidiaries.
